One Day Excursions

Place of visit: Debre Libanos, Jemma Gorge

Type of Attraction: Monasteries, rural life scenic gorges and birds

Early morning, head north on the Gojjam road to Debre Libanos at about 106 km, an important and influential monastic center for the Ethiopian Orthodox Church. We will first stop at the Jema River Gorge. The Jema river is one of the tributaries of the Nile, and there is a drop of nearly 1000 m to the valley below. Here at the gorge (and in the forest around the church) we can expect to see banded barbet, black-headed forest oriole, white-billed starling, red-billed starling, white-winged cliff chat, white-backed black tit, white-cheeked turaco and Hemprich's hornbill.

This monastery was founded by the renowned 13th century mystic Saint Teklehaimanot and there is a small cave near the church (of recent construction), where he is said to have stood for seven years on one leg, until the other wasted away and dropped off. On this tour you will be able to combine history and culture with some good bird watching. As we pass through the Sululta Plains we can see black-winged plovers, wattled ibis, blue-winged geese, common cranes and wheat eaters.

We will also see one of Ethiopia's endemic mammals, the Gelada or bleeding heart baboon. In the Jema River Gorge, we will see a variety of vultures, lammergeyers, Ruppell's and Lappet-faced vultures.

Later visit and drive back to Addis where our services end.

An excursion trip to the southernmost Rock-hewn Church of Adadi Mariam, which was built by King Lalibela between the 12th and 14th centuries AD and which is still an active worship place. It is one of the holiest places in the region. The area has spectacular scenery, surrounded by beautiful hills.

Proceed to Tiya, termed by UNESCO as a world Heritage site. Visit the peculiarly engraved stelae that are believed to have been erected between the 12th and 14th century.

Our final stop will be at Melka Kunture that lies near the Awash Gorge and archaeological site (dating back to over 1.5 million years old) which is regarded to be one of the most important stone age archeological sites of Ethiopia and it is believed to be the home of Neolithic man.

We will stop for a picnic lunch by a spectacular scenery.

Later in the day, drive back to Addis observing the scenery en route. End of our services.
